



MOBILE PHONE APPS

ARE THE MOBILE PHONE APPS YOUR CHILD USES SAFE?

Some Apps allow children to send and receive inappropriate information. This can lead to bullying, anxiety and distress for children and families.

Some facts to be noted:

1. Children are not permitted to use mobile phones at school.
2. If a child does not check his/her mobile phone into the office each morning, it will be confiscated from them and parents called.
3. Parents and carers should check the apps children have on their devices and also the age at which they are allowed to access them.
4. WPS students should not have access to problematic apps as most are for teenagers 13 years and over.
5. Supervision of internet and device use in the home is the responsibility of the parent or carer.
6. The school does not impose discipline as a result of behaviours occurring in the home.
7. We urge all parents and carers to keep their children safe by monitoring the online behaviour of children in their care.

working day before your booking. Please note that weekends and Public Holidays are Non Working Days. All bookings not
cancelled by this time will be charged at full fee.

FEES: Depending on the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) and activity hours a parent is entitled too, the out of pocket costs to
parents can range from a few dollars to the full rate shown below. To find out more about the Child Care Subsidy please visit at
<https://www.education.gov.au/ChildCarePackage>. The table below shows the full fee with no Child Care Subsidy along with
an example of the out of pocket expense where the highest rate of Child Care Subsidy is applied.

Your fee will vary depending on your own CCS rate and activity hours you receive. Unlike some providers, Community
OOSH Services strive to put you and your children first, providing the highest quality care for the lowest possible price. Please
note excursions are at an additional cost and vary depending on the excursion. The cost on each excursion are shown on the
next page and these costs will have your CCS % applied to substantially reduce excursion costs.
