Principal's Message:

Welcome back to all the students. It is great to have the school back to normal with buzz of students in the playground and around the school. Also thank you to all the parents, carers and relatives that assisted in the learning from home program.

Student awards will be handed out this Friday on assembly. Due to level 3 Covid restrictions photos will be posted on Facebook so parents and carers are able to see the awards.

Last week was School Administrative and Support Staff (SASS) recognition week. Our SASS staff play an important role in the school community. They are often the first people you see when you enter our school and are essential to maintaining positive relationships with students, parents and the community. So thanks you to all our SASS staff for the wonderful job you do in supporting the students, staff and community members of Westlawn Public School.

Here's what our families and student can expect when returning to school sites under COVID-safe Level 3 conditions:

- Staff will be required to wear masks indoors and outdoors while on school grounds.
- We will reduce overall mingling of our different student years which means no school assemblies or sport (outside of existing PDHPE classes), excursions or field trips.
- Only essential visitors will be allowed on site and will be required to check-in and wear masks at all times.
- Canteens are open with appropriate hygiene measures in place.
- Parents and carers will need to remain outside of school grounds and follow physical distancing and avoid gathering for drop-offs and pick-ups.
- There will be enhanced daily cleaning of the school and wherever possible we will ensure classrooms will be well-ventilated with open windows.
- Before and After School Care will be available on site following COVID-safe plans.

Unfortunately, at the moment all excursions and camps are on hold until level 3 restrictions ease. We currently have no information when this will occur.

Enjoy the warm weather during the September holidays and we look to seeing everyone back for a hectic term 4.

The Tell Them From Me student survey (Term 4, 2021)

Dear Parents and Carers

I am delighted that during early Term 4, Westlawn Public School, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the *Tell Them From Me* student, survey. This survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices. You may remember that our students from **Years 4 to 6** participated in a *Tell Them From Me* student survey in Term 1, this year. Asking students to complete the survey twice in one year allows us to identify trends in student responses as well as track engagement and motivation across the school year. The student survey is a great opportunity for our students to provide us with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. More than 6,300 schools in Australia and around the world have used *Tell Them From Me* to survey 5.4 million students. Capturing the voices of our students will help improve how we do things at our school.

I want to assure you that the survey is confidential. It is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between **Tuesday 5th October and Friday 15th October**. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.

If you <u>do</u> <u>not</u> want your child or children to participate, please return the form to school by Tuesday 5th October. 

Your booking requests will be confirmed by email. Please check that you receive the confirmation from us within 2 working days of submitting. The minimum notice required to cancel a Vacation Care booking where no charge will apply is 1:30pm the working day before your booking. Please note that weekends and Public Holidays are Non Working Days. All bookings not cancelled by this time will be charged at full fee.

FEES: Depending on the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) and activity hours a parent is entitled too, the out of pocket costs to parents can range from a few dollars to the full rate shown below. Your fee will vary depending on your own CCS rate and activity hours you receive.
