Covid is still in our community and the school has Rapid Antigen Tests (RAT) kits available if required, please contact the office. You may have heard that National Cabinet announced their decision to remove the isolation requirements for COVID-19 positive cases. The NSW Department of Education is working on this to make sure our COVID-smart settings are aligned when the change to isolation comes into effect on Friday 14 October. In the meantime, positive cases will be required to isolate for 7 days. An update will be provided once we have confirmation from the department.

Entry to Selective High School Year 7 in 2024. For entry to Year 7 in 2024, applications are expected to open on 18 October and close on 16 November 2022. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on May 4, 2023. The test will be paper based.

Dear parents and carers,

From this week, Westlawn Public School will participate in the *Partners in Learning* parent survey, another part of the *Tell Them from Me* suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. The survey asks parents and carers questions about different factors that are known to impact on student wellbeing and engagement. Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experience at school. These include communication between parents/carers and staff, activities and practices at home and parent/carer views on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This valuable feedback will help our school make practical improvements.

The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, iPads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take **15 minutes or less** to complete and is **completely confidential**. The parent survey will be conducted from this week to Friday 4th November. Although participating in the survey is entirely voluntary, your responses are very much appreciated.

Pool entity, presenters, coaching and lunch for the swimmers will be provided. Any additional expenses are the responsibility of the swimmers and their families.


Have you dreamed of becoming a Paralympian?
