Principal's Message:

Thank you to all the families that supported the school at the Jacaranda Youth Banner March, there was terrific support. The school also had several performances at the schools showcase day. It provided a great opportunity for parents to be able to see the outcome of all the work the students have put into preparing for their performances and they need to be acknowledged and congratulated.

The Grafton Eisteddfod also provided the opportunity for our musicians and performers to display their skills. Westlawn entered performances from Kindy through to Stage 3. Once again congratulations to the students and thankyou to the teachers for providing this opportunity.

At present we have high school transition and Kindergarten transition days occurring. The purpose of these programs is to allow the students to become familiar with the new setting they will be entering. This plays a valuable role in assisting reduce the anxiety around the change that is occurring. Please have a conversation with your child as each child will have differing concerns about entering high school or Kindergarten.

Student Attendance continues to be a focus our aim is to have 85% of students attending 90% of the time. So please make sure your child attends school every day they can. Missing a day here or there may not seem like much, but absences add up and can impact your child's learning more than you think. When your child misses one day a week over a year, that's 40 days of school, 8 weeks of lessons and 2.5 years over their school life lost.





I am disappointed I missed the Infants Sports Fun Day as I was home caring for one of my children. By all reports it was a fun and enjoyable day. I did receive plenty of reports from students as to who won what race. Thank you to Leslie, the P&C and parent helps on the day and the Infants Staff for organising the day.


