Attendance and absences

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral.

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record. We are always willing to work with families to improve the attendance of students.

New covid measures that families may not be sure about.

All family and community members are able to attend assemblies and parades.

All volunteers working with students require double vaccination, (see your classroom teacher if you are available to volunteer).

If your child is self isolating or absent due to covid- student learning is through the online learning packages: https://education.nsw.gov.au/.../2022-digital.../primary

and select the appropriate year level.

Always report to the office to sign in if volunteering or to sign your child in/out if arriving late or leaving early.


Congratulations to our top borrowing classes 2C for infants and 3/4M for Primary in the month of March. It was wonderful to see 1584 books borrowed in March!


