## Westlawn Wheelathon 2022

### BIKES:

Kindergarten children are asked to line their bikes up outside KB's classroom, where there will be a designated parking area for Kindergarten students.

Year 1 and 2 children are asked to line their bikes up near the stairs to 1AW's classroom, where there will be a designated parking area for students.

Primary students will lock up their bikes using the bike racks. There will be an additional designated parking area on the primary playground near the back of the canteen.
