Principal's Message:

Smart watches

Before and After School

The school bell goes and 8:25am students should not be at school before this time as there is no supervision. The afternoon bell goes at 2:55pm and students are required to be collected in a reasonable time. There is no supervision after school and alternative arrangements need to be made if you cannot collect your child at bell time. This is for the safety of your children. Out of School Care collects and drops students to school each day.

Students from our school have recently undertaken an education tour of the national capital. Students will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$67.50 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate Program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.
