## **Building positive attendance habits**

You can help build positive attendance habits by:

- · helping your child learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- · making sure your child arrives on time from the start of the school day, ready to take part
- · reducing disruption to learning where you can, by planning any necessary appointments outside of school time



- · contacting your school to explain any absences (within 7 days of the first day of any absence)
- · making sure any holidays or medical appointments are taken outside school hours
- · working with the school to encourage and support regular attendance.

Later this term Westlawn Public School will begin to use School Bytes as our main form of communication. Payments can already be made using this app and as the term goes on communication and permission notes will also be made through School Bytes Parent Portal, more information to come.

#### **External Service Providers**

We would like to thank the parents and carers who took the time to complete and return the *Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ)* form that was distributed to all Kindergarten-Year 2 students in Term 1. The results of the *SDQ form* helps identify children who would benefit from being included in the *Got It!* group program.

The Got It! group program will be running in both **Term 2 & Term 3** at Westlawn Public School. Parents of children in classes: 1P, 2C, 2W & 2M have now been contacted for the group program commencing in Term 2. **During Weeks 2 & 3 of Term 2**, the Got It! Team will be contacting parents of children from 1H, 1J, KC, KA & KG who would benefit from being included in the Got It! group program running Term 3 at Westlawn Public School.
